



SAFE FOR DOCUMENTS

GENERAL

Safe for documents are used to store all your paper documents and protect them from damage. They are equipped with a thermal insulator which delays the penetration of fire into the safe.

STANDARDIZATION

NT FIRE 017: Swedish standard that is the reference on the market for document and data storage cabinets. There are 3 types: 30, 60 and 90 minutes.

ISO 1182 EUROPEAN STANDARD NF EN ISO 1182 : This standard is a test standard for the non-combustibility of construction products (thermal insulation).

FIRE RESISTANT SAFE FOR DOCUMENTS

GENERAL

To protect people and property, it is necessary to equip your premises with fireproof materials.

Ashtrays and safety bins will make it possible to contain the start of a fire by confining and smothering it within the ashtray or bin itself, as soon as it starts.

The fire blankets will make it possible to smother the start of a fire, both on a person or on an object, but they can also be used as a heat shield in the event of a serious fire.

STANDARDIZATION

EN 1869-1997 EUROPEAN STANDARD 1869-1997: This standard stipulates that the blanket must be able to withstand heat of approximately 900°C caused by flaming soybean or rapeseed oil. The electrical resistance of the cover must not be less than 1 Ohm.
